

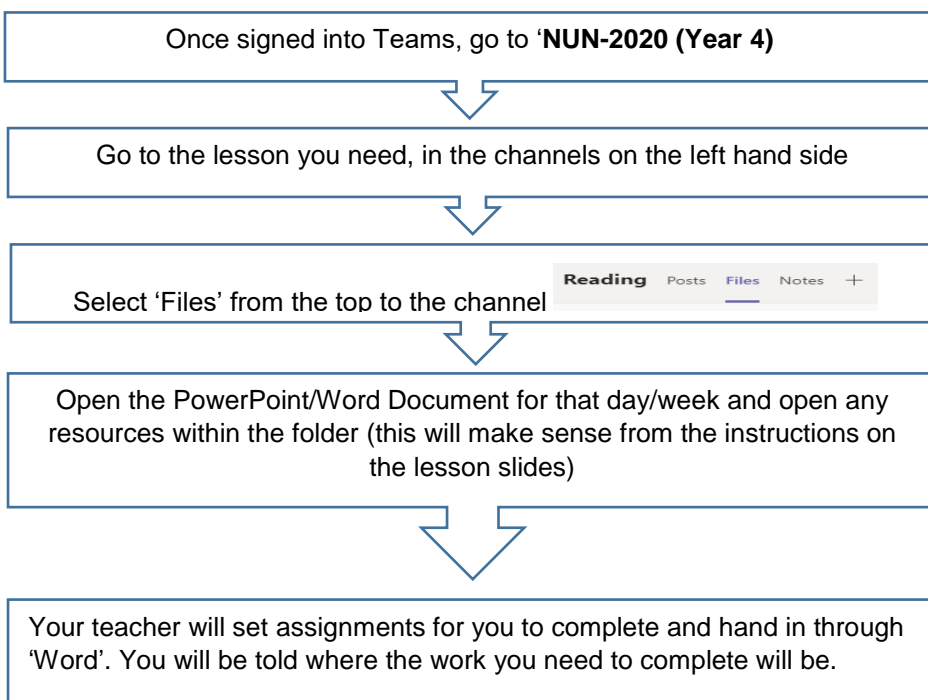
REMOTE LEARNING FOR YEAR 4

Where will I find the learning?	All learning will be done through Microsoft Teams . Your child can access this through googling Microsoft Teams (or downloading the app), and signing in using their school Microsoft password . You can access this from a laptop, PC, tablet, mobile phone, Xbox or PlayStation at home. Your child will be doing the same work that the children in class are doing. Teachers will upload the lesson slides and the work set in lessons onto Microsoft Teams each day.

How will we know what to do?	There is a suggested timetable below which will tell you where to find learning. You must join the 'live' lessons at the set time; other than that, you can be flexible.
