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COVID GUIDANCE

My child has COVID symptoms



Your child must self-isolate. Don't come to school; don't play out. Book a PCR. (An LFT test might give you a result, but these are designed to be used by people without symptoms.)

My child has no symptoms but has had a positive LFT test



Your child must self-isolate. Don't come to school; don't play out. You DO NOT need to book a PCR unless your child develops symptoms.



Let us know as soon as you can. It helps if we know:

- The first date of symptoms, if your child has symptoms
- The date of the positive LFT, if your child has one
- The PCR result, if your child needs to take one



We will text you with your child's return date. It will be ten days from the date of their symptoms or their positive test (this is Day Zero). If you get a different date from Test and Trace, please let us know for our records.



They might be able to return to school BEFORE the ten days are up, as the government has updated the isolation guidance. They will need 2 negative LFT tests, taken 24 hours apart, from DAY 5. Please get in touch if you would like us to help you work these dates out! Please let us know the outcome of these LFTs.



RETURNING TO SCHOOL

Whether your child does the full self-isolation period or comes back early with the negative LFTs, they can only come back to school if they do not have a temperature. They might still have a cough, or a loss of taste and smell, as these symptoms can last a while.

iPads and chargers

What an incredible resource! They are transforming learning in the classroom and are used EVERY DAY. Make sure they are fully charged and brought to school daily. They should be in a bag to protect them on the school run. Let us know of any issues or damage so we can act swiftly. Remember you can be charged for damages, so look after them at home and make sure your child uses them safely and sensibly.

If the iPad isn't in school, we will contact you and ask you to bring it in, so your child can join in fully with their lessons.

MASKS

We ask that you wear a mask AT ALL TIMES on school grounds, unless you are exempt.

I am asking staff to keep socially distanced at home times so they won't be available to chat to you. If you need to speak to a member of staff, please chat to those of us on the gate in the morning or email us. We will pass messages on and someone will always get back to you.

MOBILE PHONES

Pupil mobile phones are NOT permitted in class or in bags, under any circumstances.

However we do understand that you might need your child to have their phone with them for before/after school.

Your child may hand their phone to the teacher for safe keeping and then collect it at home time.

Any phone that is in school and not handed in will be confiscated and then will need to be collected by a parent.



JEWELLERY REMINDER

The only jewellery permitted in school are STUD EARRINGS and a watch.

Earrings need to be removed for PE; if your child is not able to remove them independently, please make sure they are not worn on PE days.

SMART watches are not to be worn; messages and calls are distracting.

If your child comes to school wearing jewellery that is not permitted we will ask you to come and collect it.

Please remember that fees for lunchtime supervision and/or extra sessions must be paid for IN ADVANCE. Please ask the office for a copy of your contract if you are unsure.

If fees are not up to date, your child will not be able to attend the session and you will be asked to collect them. Any problems, please just talk to us.
